PAPINEAU A WILLING SACRIFICE FOR THE GOOD OF THE EMPIRE

(Special Cable By F. A. MacKenzie. Copyright.) London, Nov. 8.—Among the many distinguished names of officers in the casualty list that of Captain Talbot M. Papineau attracts special attention.

He was one of the most popular army men. His readiness in the charge, and distinguished gallantry won him friends everywhere. He served for some time on the general staff.

Some months ago he had the choice between accepting a "cashy" (high position) in the rear or a company command. He talked over the matter with friends:

"I want to do work with the army that will increase my influence among my fellow French-Canadians," he said. "I want, when I return to be able to influence them for the good of our empire."

So he went to his battalion and fell leading his men in battle. The captain rider Haggard of an eastern Ontario regiment, and a nephew of the great author, who left the Bank of Montreal to join the Princess Pats, fought in the second battle of Ypres, was once involved with frozen feet, and once wounded and had been fighting ever since, was killed in October. He served recently under command of Major Papineau, who, killed almost at the same time.

Charles M. Stewart Died of Wounds. Perth, Nov. 8.—(Special)—Friends throughout the maritime and upper provinces will deeply regret to learn of the death of Sergeant Charles M. Stewart, of Perth (N. B.), who has been officially reported to have died of wounds "somewhere in France" in October 23.

Sergeant Stewart was a son of James Stewart, the well known railway contractor, and for some years previous to his enlistment had been associated with his father under the firm name of James Stewart & Son.

Upon the completion of his last contract he enlisted with the Royal Engineers and was later transferred to the Canadian troops with which he was serving at the time of his death. He had recently spent five months at Vimy Ridge.

Sergeant Stewart was thirty-one years of age, and besides his father is survived by a widow and one child residing in Chapeau (Ont.). Three brothers, Murchie and Herman, of Perth; Burton, a prominent railway contractor at present at Trochu (Ont.), and three sisters, Mrs. L. A. Fenwick, of Jacksonville (N. B.), and the Misses Annie and Esme, of Perth, also survive.

Warren Read Killed in Action. Sackville, Nov. 8.—Warren Read, of Cookville, was recently killed in action, word to that effect reaching Sackville recently. He was the son of the late Frank Read, of Cookville, and for two years or more was employed with F. W. Wry in the C. P. R. office here. He is survived by three sisters and seven brothers. The sisters are Mrs. Eva Nelson, Medford (Mass.); Mrs. Murray Cook, Cookville; Miss Gladys Read, Minneapolis. The brothers are Robert, Moncton; Edgar, Trueman, James and Elphaleth, in the west; John, of Minneapolis (Minn.); Harry, of Cookville. The deceased young man had many friends who will regret to hear of his death. He was about 22 years of age.

now it has not occurred to me that I did not write you personally in relation to the death of your son, James Lynott, of the 24th V. B. C., from wounds received on the night of the 11th. He was struck by seventeen pieces of shrapnel from a H. E. shell. His strong constitution gave us hope that he would come through all right. His presence of mind after being hit was the same that had characterized him in the most dangerous task of getting back a message for the present O. C., then O. C. of company, getting through under terrific rifle and machine gun fire by jumping from shell hole to shell hole. He thus earned the admiration of both officers and men.

Personally I had reached a close stage of friendship with "Jim" during those long fall and winter nights of waiting, I pause the greater while he is buried the other day in a little French village behind the line, and notes that the good sisters who are always honoring the dead had placed flowers on his grave and those of his comrades who form several great rows in the pretty and peaceful yard. I hope that Lieutenant McLaughlin (a great friend of mine) and I may some day describe to you person by person the details of how James Lynott lived a brave and daring soldier and died a "soldier's death."

Women Left Estate Of Two Millions and Half New York, Nov. 9.—The estate of Miss Susan Mount, last surviving member of an old New York family, who died on May 2 after a long illness, was valued at \$2,000,000. She gave \$15,000 each to seven institutions, \$10,000 each to four societies, and institutions, and \$25,000 each to two. She left \$50,000 to Protestant Episcopal Bishop White, trustee of Missouri to erect a memorial church in his diocese. Her servant, Katie E. Cottrell, got a cancelled mortgage for \$20,000 and a check for \$20,000. The bulk of the estate went to Edward H. and Harold K. Mount, grandnephews, who got \$1,117,000 each.
