It will be observed that, in accordance with the provisions of the law, the rate of duty per Imperial gallon is arrived at, by adding onefifth of the rate per Wine gallon.

Quantities stated in Wine gallons may be reduced to Imperial gallons by deducting one-sixth, or the quantity stated in Imperial gallons may be reduced to Wine gallons by adding one-fifth thus :--

20 Imperial gallons = 24 Wine gallons. 24 Wine do = 20 Imperial do.
