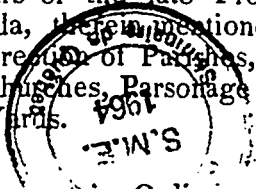


BILL

To render permanent two Ordinances of the Governor and Special Council for the affairs of the late Province of Lower Canada, the first mentioned, concerning the erection of Parishes, and the building of Churches, Parsonage Houses, and Church Yards.



WHEREAS a certain Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada, by and with the advice and consent of the Special Council for the affairs of the 5 said Province, made and passed in the second year of the Reign of Her Majesty, intituled "An Ordinance concerning the erection of Parishes, and the building of Churches, Parsonage Houses, and Church 10 Yards," and a certain other Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council, made and passed in the fourth year of the Reign of Her Majesty intituled "An Ordinance to extend the provisions of a certain 15 Ordinance concerning the erection of Parishes for civil purposes, to Parishes canonically erected before the passing of the said Ordinance," will speedily expire. And whereas, it is just and expedient that the 20 said Ordinances should be rendered permanent. Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the 25 Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, intituled "An Act to Reunite the Provinces 30 of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada;" and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada, by and with the 35 advice and consent of the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province, made
