An Act to regulate Freight and Passenger Rates on Railways.

ER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as tollows :-

(a.) The expression "railway" includes all bridges and "railway." rries used or operated in converting and "railway." 1. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, ferries used or operated in connection with a railway, and also all the road in use by any corporation operating a railroad, whether owned or operated under a contract, agreement or

- (b.) The expression "transportation" includes all instru-"Transporta-10 mentalities of shipment or carriage.
 - (c.) The expression "carrier" means and includes every "Carrier." common carrier to which this Act applies.
- 2. This Act shall apply to common carriers engaged in the Application 15 transportation of passengers or property wholly by railway or of Act. partly by railway and partly by water when both are used, under a common control, management or arrangement, for a continuous carriage or shipment, from one province of Canada to another province of Canada, or from any place in Canada to 20 an adjacent foreign country, or from any place in Canada through a foreign country to any other place in Canada, and also to the transportation in like manner of property shipped 1. om any place in Canada to a foreign country and carried from such place to a port of transhipment, or shipped from a 25 toreign country to any place in Canada and carried to such place from a port of entry either in Canada or in an adjacent foreign country: Provided, however, that this Act shall not apply to the transportation of passengers or property, or to the receiving, delivering, storage, or handling of property wholly within one 30 province and not shipped to or from a foreign country from or to any province as aforesaid.
- 3. All charges made for any service rendered or to be Charges to be rendered in the transportation of passengers or property as reasonable. aforesaid, or in connection therewith, or for the receiving, 35 delivering, storage, or handling of such property shall be reasonable and just; and every unjust and unreasonable charge for such service is prohibited.
- 4. If any carrier directly or indirectly, by any special rate, No special rebate, drawback, or other device, charges, demands, collects made. 40 or receives from any person, a greater or less compensation for
