REGINA, SASK. August 29, 1924.

Sire-

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, your file No. 23108-7 with reference to proposed change in road in the S.E. 1/4 of section 5, township 19, range 5, west of the 2nd meridian, which quarter section lies within the limits of Indian Reserve No. 72A.

I note that you request that an Order in Council of this government be issued transferring to His Majesty as represented by the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs the area in the old roadway. In this connection I beg to refer you to your file No. 37558 and to your letter of the 7th of March, 1907 from which you will note that only a reservation for the old road was made in your records, and that no Order-in-Council has been passed by the Dominion Government transferring the same to the Crown in the right of this Province, therefore, we do not consider it will be necessary for us to have an Order-in-Council passed transferring the old road to the Dominion.

In 1914 however, the Registrar in the believe that this quarter section was dominion land issued title to the road in the S.E. 1/4 of 5 in the name of His Majesty the King, in the right and to the use of His Province of Saskatchewan. As an error was made in the issuing of the said title we are today petitioning the Master of Titles to issue an order to the Registrar to cancel the said title, and to consolidate the land mentioned therein with the balance of the S.E. 1/4 of 5.

The original of this document has been removed for retention in the Records of the Indian Land Registry.
