- (1) Mr. and Mrs. Baldwin, after Canadian Club Luncheon, proceed to Main Entrance, Houses of Parliament; they will be met there by the Prime Minister and taken to the Memorial Chamber.

- (2) 2.30 p.m. Invited guests to the number of 50 assemble in Hall of Fame.
- (3) 2.50 p.m. His Royal Highness and His Excellency arrive, (accompanied by Staffs).
- (4) Guard of Honour. Royal Salute.
 6 bars of National Anthem. Inspection of Guard.
 Band playing.
- (5) His Excellency and all Staff that can be spared will proceed at once to the Chamber followed by the invited guests who will be marshalled to their places.
- (6) 2.55 p.m. Reception of His Royal Highness by Prime Minister at the Main Entrance.
- (7) Proceed to Chamber, by elevator.
 Representatives of Army, Navy, Air and Nursing Service at upper door of elevator.
- (8) 3.00 p.m. Clock strikes three
- (9) Prime Minister requests H.R.H. to dedicate Chamber. (2 minutes).
- (10) His Royal Highness unveils the Altar and pronounces Dedication. (1 minute)
 Simultaneously flag on Tower is dipped.
 Guard presents arms and ~~dips colour.~~ (General Salute)
