MEMORANDUM FOR MR. HEENEY:

A letter dated September 28 from Mr. Caldwell concerning the application of censorship at times of elections was referred in Cabinet today to Mr. McLarty as Chairman of the Censorship Committee for the purpose of having an appropriate reply prepared.

It was suggested that a careful statement of the whole censorship matter should be prepared by Mr. Thompson and Mr. Gladstone Murray acting in conjunction under Mr. McLarty, which statement could be given to the press, and also used as a part of the reply to Mr. Caldwell.

The letter is now in Mr. McLarty's hands, and I shall be obliged if you will have the matter followed up so that I may make as early a reply as possible to Mr. Caldwell.
