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Ottawa 22nd April, 1902.

Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 10th instant, with which you forwarded voucher No 967 accounting for the sum of \$30.00 disbursed by Mr Agent Bell on account of travelling expenses during March last, I beg to say that a further advance of \$100.00 has been made to him.

In this connection I have to request that you will kindly ask Mr Bell to forward a diary for the month of March giving information in regard to the Indians whom he visited, and their condition. His diary should also show what business he transacted. There is practically no information of this nature in the diary which accompanied the Voucher above mentioned.
