I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo, addressed to the Secretary of the Department of the Interior, in connection with Sec. 6, Tp. 43, R. 26, W. 4th, and in reply to say that this section was included in the lands surrendered some years ago by the Indians to be sold for their benefit, but was not disposed of with the other lands surrendered, and is not at present in the market for sale, as it is proposed to offer it for sale at some future date by public auction, when other lands in the neighborhood are being sold.
