

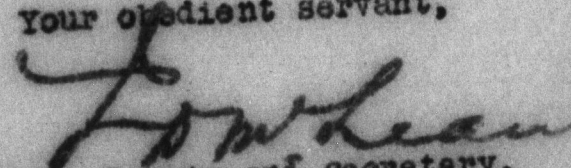
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Ottawa, April 4, 1919.

Sir,-

In further reference to your letter of the 5th ultimo, in which you ask whether this Department will co-operate with you in the establishment of a school for the white settlers and half-breeds residing near the Dog Creek Reserve, I beg to say that the Department is advised that the Indian children on this reserve are too far away from the half-breed settlement to attend a school situated there. The Department is, therefore, not prepared to contribute towards a joint school at this point.
