Reverend Sir,-


I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant, regarding Tillie Akibimosee (Shinos) who is at the Spanish Industrial School.

Last fall the Department received an affidavit from the father of this girl setting forth that for the past five years he has been a protestant.

In view of this man's affidavit and the further fact that he has never signed any application for the admission of this girl to the Spanish Industrial School, it is considered that as he now asks that the girl be returned to him, his request should be acceded to.

Kindly communicate with Mr. Acting Agent McGregor, who will, no doubt, be in a position to inform you where the father is living at the present time.
