To remove the possibility of any question being raised as to the moral right as well as the legal power of the administration to complete freedom of action ^{at} with respect to the method of raising men for military service, ¹ legislative provision was ^{accordingly} made to seek from the people, by means of a plebiscite, release from any obligation arising out of any past commitments. ⁺ By their vote on the plebiscite, the people ^{overwhelmingly expressed} ~~left no room for doubt that~~, ^{that} in their opinion, the government should possess complete freedom to act in accordance with its judgment of the needs of the situation as they might arise. That freedom of action, parliament subsequently ^{established} ~~proved beyond~~ ^{doubt} question by an amendment to the National Resources Mobilization Act.

This advice wished to ^{establish beyond question} ~~place beyond question~~ its moral right as well as its legal power to complete freedom of action at ~~the~~ ^{the} time of greatest crisis.
