CROSS EXAMINED BY PROSECUTOR:-

- Q.309 Exhibit "J", form 513, what can you say about that signature, is it yours?
 A.309 I wouldn't say for sure. I am not certain.
- Q.310 The Pay Sergeant is not telling the truth then? You heard the evidence.
 A.310 I will say it is my signature.
- Q.311 Exhibit "I", what do you say about that signature, is it yours?
 A.311 No, sir.
- Q.312 You already stated that it was, which are you going to stand by?
 A.312 I didn't say definitely, I said it was funny in ink and the rest in pencil. That is my signature.
- Q.313 You know Gar. Schriver?
 A.313 Yes, sir.
- Q.314 You heard him give evidence about having some conversation about a train time table?
 A.314 Yes, sir.
- Q.315 Where did that take place?
 A.315 I do not know, sir.
- Q.316 Were you there?
 A.316 No, sir, I was not there.
- Q.317 Gar. Schriver and Gar. Hamilton are lying then?
 A.317 Yes, sir. What date was that, sir?
- Q.318 About the 13th.
 A.318 I am definitely sure there was no argument about trains.
- Q.319 Were they good friends of yours, no trouble with them?
 A.319 Nothing at all, sir.
- Q.320 Any reason why they would say anything about having a little talk with you in the kitchen about train times?
 A.320 No, sir, I don't see any reason for that. As I said before there was a time table outside the Battery office and there was no reason for an argument.
- Q.321 You heard the evidence of two men that you say have nothing against you, who stated right here before this court about having a discussion about train tables on day. You took a slip of paper out of your pocket, what do you have to say about that?
 A.321 That is not true, I took no paper out of my pocket, in fact I wasn't there to take it out of my pocket.
- Q.322 I suggest you did take it out of your pocket, you said one time that you did and another that you didn't, this time you have no recollection about it. There was a meeting and an argument?
 A.322 There was no argument in that kitchen and what's more any day that I wasn't on duty I always was out in the country 7 miles away getting eggs. That handwriting on Exhibit "F" is not my writing.
- Q.323 What is your home address?
 A.323 Newcastle, New Brunswick, sir.
- Q.324 You stated a while ago that this minister was a minister of the C. of E. Where?
 A.324 At Newcastle, N.B., sir.
- Q.325 There is a book with Newcastle on it, and the name of the minister from Newcastle, can you tell me any reason why anybody else would have that book?

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
