Which plan being highly approved of by the majority of the meeting, they then appointed a Committee to form Rules and Regulations for the fulfilling of their intentions and the well-being and government thereof, which Rules were approved of by the Society and subscribed to by every Member.—These Regulations being found defective in many points, the Society unanimously voted a Resolution on the 5th June 1793, to have them revised, and appointed a Committee for the purpose, who have made report of their proceedings, which are the following Rules to be henceforth the basis of their Institution, and were unanimously approved and subscribed unto.

ARTICLE I. THAT this Society shall meet the first Wednesday in each calendar month from the month of May to September, at the hour of seven, P. M., and from the month of Sep-
