The term "vicinity" used above is meant to indicate the same town, township or an adjoining or cornering township. A settler who avails himself of the provisions of Clauses (2), (2) per (4) must cultivate 30 acress of his homestead, or substitute 30 head of stock, with buildings of their secommodation, and have besides 80 acres substantially fenced.

The privilege of a second entry is restricted by law to those settions only who completed the durins upon their first homesteads to entitle them to patent on or before the Smd June, 1889. By homesteader who fails to comply with the requirements of the homestead is wis liable to ave his entry cancelled, and the land may be again throw open for entry. APPLICATION FOR PATENT

should be made at the end of three years, before the Local Agent, Sub Agent, or the Homestad Improtor. Before making application fo patent, the settler must give air meather solice in writing to the Com missioner of Dominion Lands, at Ottawa, of his intention to do sa
