On Easter Day there will be three Celebrations of the Holy Communion at 7, 8 and 11.45 a.m. Let every member of the Congregation who has been Confirmed put forth a special effort to make their Easter Communion at one or other of these Services.

EASTER OFFERING envelopes will be distributed amongst our Congregation on Palm Sunday and we confidently hope that the Lenten Savings amongst our people will greatly increase the Easter Offertory. A liberal offering is needed for two special objects, viz.: 1. The payment to the Episcopal Endowment Fund, for which \$69 is required; and, 2, the much more prosaic but very necessary coal bill for the year, for which we want \$250.
