

The sweepstakes mare was Galbraith's Ben Ledi Flower, the first-prize three-year-old filly, who was also the sweepstakes female. M. E. Sutton, Roland, was first in two-year-old fillies, with May Darnley, and John Wishart, Portage la ing.
