Mr. Viger moved, feconded by Mr. François Caron;

That a Committee of five Members be appointed to draw up reafons to be offered to the Legislative Council, at a conference, for disagreeing to the amendments made by their Honors to the Bill for continuing the several Laws in force which authorise the Justices of the Peace to make Rules and Regulations of Police, and in which this House hath not concurred.

The House divided upon the question:

Yeas 12 Nays 5

So it was carried in the affirmative, and

RESOLVED, accordingly.

ORDERED, that Messieurs Viger, Papineau, junr. François Caron, Blanchet, and Durocher, do compose the said Committee.

The order of the day, for the House to resolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, on the report of the Special Committee appointed to enquire into the fittest places for erecting Houses of Correction in the Districts of Quebec, Montreal, and Three Rivers, respectively, and the expenses that are likely to be incurred in constructing the same, being read;

Mr. Papineau, junior, moved, seconded by Mr. Langlois;

That the said order of the day be postponed 'till Wednesday next.

The House divided on the question:

Yeas 7 Nays 11

So it passed in the negative.
