SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTHWEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead 1/4 a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.

The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties: Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, solely owned and occupied by him or his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

Pre-emption right, and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts, price \$3.00 per acre. Duties: Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate 5 acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.
