Lessons by Correspondence!

A number of teachers and private students are desirous of obtaining help in their studies and are unable to secure it near their homes. I have, therefore, organized courses of study (each course consisting of 20 lessons) in the subjects named below, the work being done by correspondence. Twenty notes of lessons are provided for each student, 20 tests are likewise provided and the students' answers are carefully reviewed and corrected. Each student has the privilege of asking for any information or help needed in connection with the course.

The fee for each course is \$12.00 and include text books, mathematical instruments (where required), blank exercise books for the answering of the tests; the fee is, in fact, inclusive. Each lesson is set for a week's work and will occupy about five hours a week of the time of the average student. Students cannot take Course 3 unless they are masters of Course 2, nor Course 2 unless they are masters of Course 1.

Some of these courses may be helpful to busy teachers who have classes in them.
