Lord Cave's Bill to Relieve Husbands

The text has been issued of Lord Cave's bill to give effect to the Government's proposal legislating to remove the liability under which a husband is placed for the wrongdoing of his wife.

It applies only to England and

Wales and provides that the husband of a married woman shall not as such be liable to be sued or be made a party to any action or legal proceeding brought against her in respect of any sort committed by her whether before or after the marriage.

This is not to apply to proceedings begun before May 28 this year. It is proposed in Section 14 of the Married Women's Property Act, 1882, to repeal

the words "and wrongs committed." Section 14 as it now stands says: A husband shall be liable for the debts of his wife contracted, and for all contracts entered into and wrongs committed by her, before marriage.
