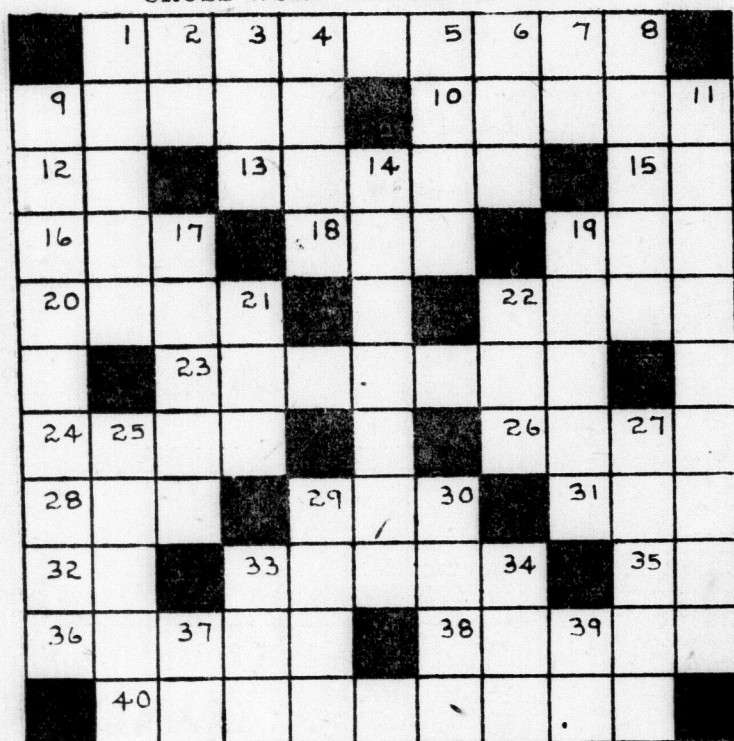


The entente cordiale. A British and a French officer lunch together on the roadside during the recent manoeuvres in Hampshire.

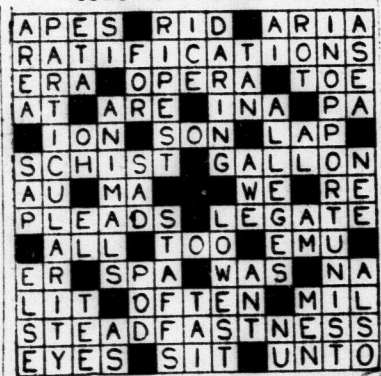

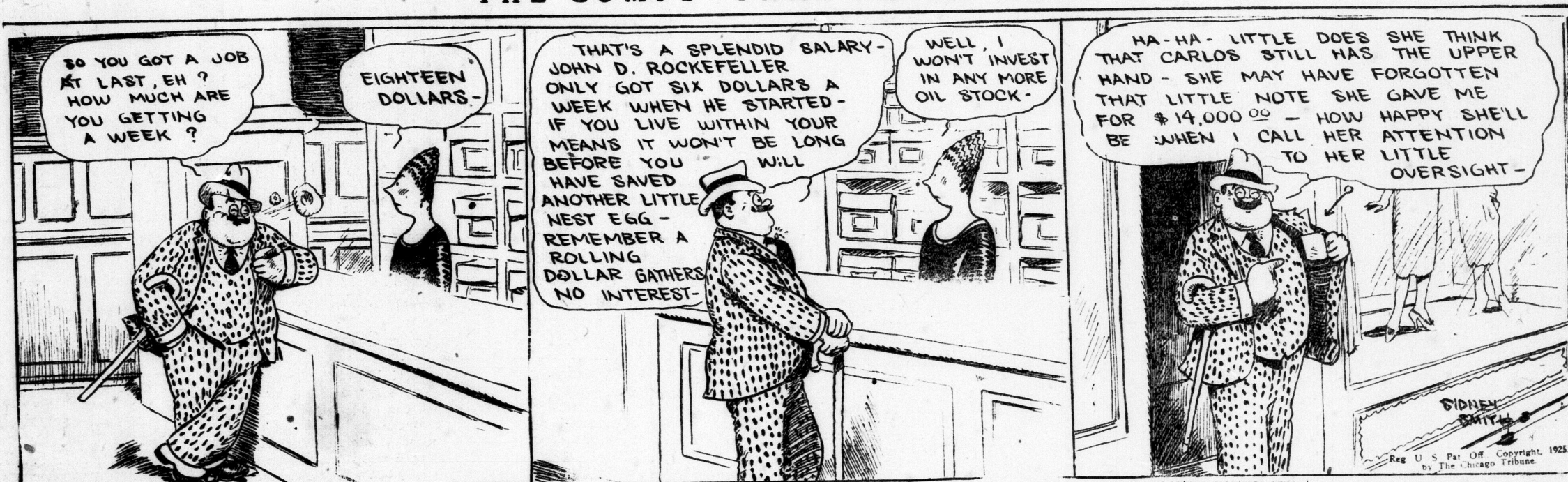
