**COMPUNING A FELONY.**

**FOUR OFFICERS SUMMONED TO ANSWER CHARGE.**  
Alexander Manning, H. A. Strath, Elias Rogers and Dr. Manning—The four officers of the Toronto Police Force were summoned to answer a charge of compounding a felony.

Yesterday evening each of these gentlemen was served with a summons to appear before Police Magistrate Manning this morning to answer to the charge of compounding a felony.

The trouble arises out of the well known case of William Selby, who is now in jail awaiting trial on the charge of having forged notes to the amount of \$10,000.

The four gentlemen named, as charged with having compounded a felony by being parties to the forgery of the notes, Selby and Thomas B. Taylor had been in business as paper makers and wholesale stationers at 33 and 35 St. Patrick Street, Toronto, for many years.

On Jan. 1, 1887, he deposited a \$1000 note bearing the alleged signature of his partner, Taylor, Bro. The paper and the note were examined by the Police Magistrate, who pronounced the signature a forgery.

This night Selby was brought from his home at "Edmondston" to the Police Station, where he was committed to the custody of the Police Magistrate, who was assisted by Mr. Manning, Director of the Police Force, and Mr. Rogers, his partner in the business.

Selby told his partner that he had forged the paper because he was short of funds. "As a matter of fact," he said, "I had no money and I was in a desperate straits."

A second summons was served on Manager Strath to answer the charge of being a party to the forgery of the notes.

The information was sworn to yesterday morning by Detective Inspector Clark before the Police Magistrate. The summons were served on the following persons: H. A. Strath, Elias Rogers, Dr. Manning, and Thomas B. Taylor.
