A FAMOUS SCULPTOR DEAD.

FOUND LIES IN HIS GRAVE BY FINANCIAL LOUSE.

Who Had Called at His Studio With Respect to a Bust He Was Executing of Bismarck. The Government Asked to Remove the Bust from the National Academy.

LONDON, Dec. 12.—Joseph Alfred Boehm, a famous sculptor, died suddenly, from heart disease, it is thought, in his studio this evening. He was engaged on a bust of Prince Louis and the latter called at the studio in relation to the work. She found the artist's dead body in a chair. Shocked, the Princess fled and gave the alarm.
