
Scientific Forging and High Grade Bicycles.

One of the chief points of difference between a low grade and a high grade bicycle is in the frame connection the joints and brackets. Many makers use a malleable casting or a sheet steel stamping costing but a few cents. On the "Massoy-Harris" nothing but steel forgings are used, being the most perfect and strongest joint obtainable. For instance, the crank hanger bracket in the rough weighs seventy ounces, and when drilled and inachined ready for brazing its weight is but twelve ounces a costly but a sure way of making a good job.
