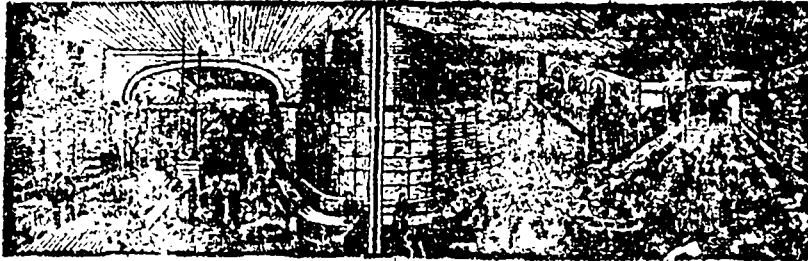


# INTERIOR VIEW

OF THE FIRST FLOOR OF

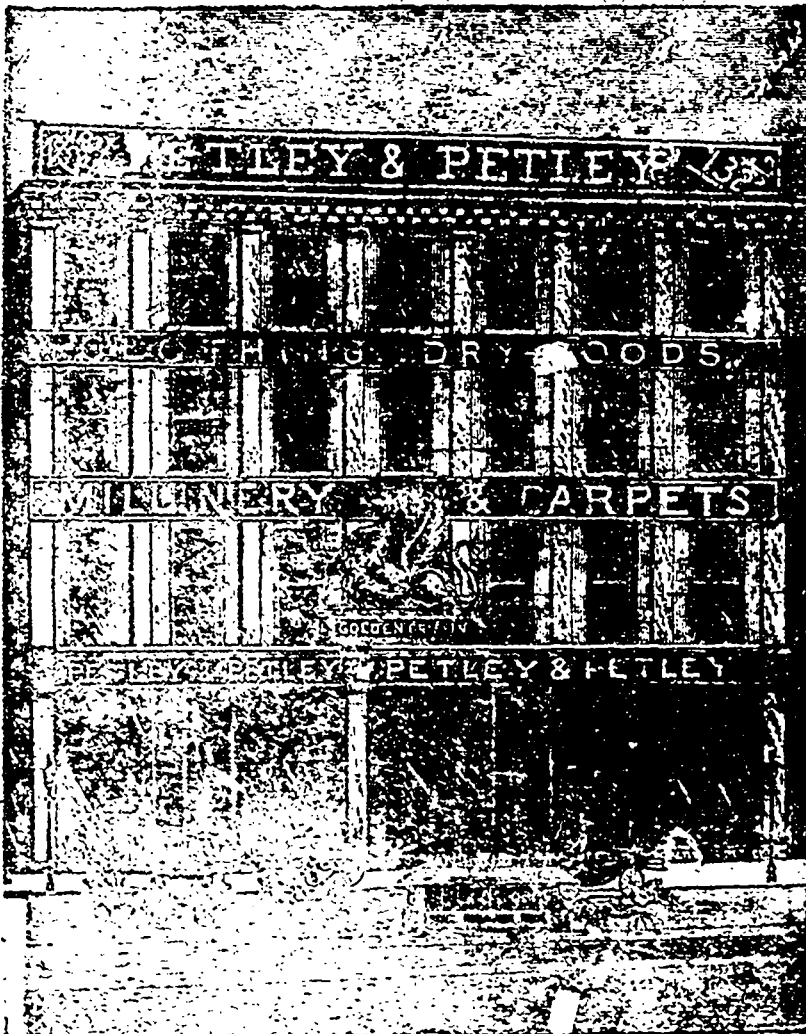
