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The Kirkpatrick Match. A challenge cup, presented for annual competition by Lieut. Col. the Hon. G. A. Kirkpatrick, Lieut. Governor of Ontario and ex-president of the D. R. Association and \$704 added by the association. The individual prizes open to all members and associate members of the association. The challenge cup and team prizes open to teams of five officers, non-coms. or men, who are efficient members of the active militia, from each of the military districts of Canada, whose names shall have been given in writing to the secretary of the D. R. A. not later than 10 a.m. on Wednesday, August 30. Any number of teams from a district may enter and need not necessarily be composed of members of the same corps but may or may not be made up of members of different corps belonging to the same district. The cup to be held for the year by the Deputy Assistant General of the district to which the winning team belongs, and to be returned to the treasurer of the D. R. Association not later than Aug. 17, 1894. Ranges, 500 and 600 yards, 10 rounds at each range; position, at 500 yards, any, with head to target; at 600 yards, any.
