

A Message was brought from the House of Commons by their Clerk with a Bill (86), intituled: "An Act to amend The Farmers' Creditors Arrangement Act, 1934," to which they desire the concurrence of the Senate.

The said Bill was read the first time, and—

With leave of the Senate, it was—

Ordered, That it be placed on the Orders of the Day for a second reading to-morrow.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Bill (64), intituled: "An Act respecting a certain Trade Agreement between Canada and the United States of America," was read the second time.

With leave of the Senate,

The said Bill was then read the third time.

The question was put whether this Bill shall pass.

It was resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That a Message be sent to the House of Commons to acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill, without any amendment.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Bill (D-2), intituled: "An Act for the relief of Helen Kerr Hogg Molson," was, on division, read the second time, and—

Ordered, That it be placed on the Orders of the Day for a third reading to-morrow.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Bill (E-2), intituled: "An Act for the relief of Adele Adfeldt Grunau," was, on division, read the second time, and—

Ordered, That it be placed on the Orders of the Day for a third reading to-morrow.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Bill (F-2), intituled: "An Act for the relief of Jeanne Beauregard Desnoyers," was, on division, read the second time, and—

Ordered, That it be placed on the Orders of the Day for a third reading to-morrow.

The Order of the Day being called for resuming the adjourned debate on the motion of the Honourable Senator Moraud:—

That the Parliamentary fees paid during the 1937 Session upon the Bill (H), intituled: "An Act respecting Industrial Loan and Finance Corporation," be refunded to the Corporation, less printing and translation costs.

It was ordered, That the said Order of the Day be postponed until Tuesday, next.

The Senate adjourned.
