An Act to amend the Railway Act. (Aid for Railway Crossings.)

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Subsection one of section 239A of the *Railway Act*, Revised Statutes of Canada, 1906, chapter thirty-seven, as enacted by chapter fifty of the statutes of 1914, is repealed and the following is substituted therefor:— 5

“**239A.** The sum of two hundred thousand dollars each year for ten consecutive years from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, shall be appropriated and set apart from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada to aid actual construction work for the protection, safety and convenience of the public in respect of highway crossings of railways at rail level, in existence on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen.” 10
