

greatly contribute to the stabilization of the market system in the country.

Here is another important clause:

(g) Clause 32(2) already stipulates that a court cannot hand down a conviction if it is established that an agreement relates only to some particular questions. These questions are complemented by agreements on the size or on the shape of containers, the adoption of the metric system and measures for the protection of the environment.

The bill also includes new proposals providing for the presentation, when the proof is made, of non-confidential

official statistics and it indicates how they should be prepared and presented.

Mr. Speaker, I did not deal with all subjects covered in this bill but I think I did mention enough to show hon. members that the legislation introduced by the Minister of Consumer and Corporate Affairs (Mr. Gray) should be supported unanimously by all members who have at heart the promotion and progress of the Canadian economy.
