**The Acting Speaker (Mr. Blaker):** Order, please. The Hon. Member for Western Arctic (Mr. Nickerson).

**Mr. Dave Nickerson (Western Arctic):** Thank you, Mr. Speaker, for recognizing me at this point in time. According to my calculations, I have two minutes in which to register my indignation that for the fifteenth time this Government has used closure during this single session of Parliament.

The reasons on this particular occasion are ones which we cannot possibly condone. The explanation given by the Minister of National Health and Welfare (Miss Bégin) was that she had heard enough from Opposition Members of Parliament, that in her consideration there was no necessity for debating the matter any longer. I remind the Minister that it is not up to her to decide whether debate has gone on a sufficient length of time. These matters are covered by the Standing Orders of the House of Commons. They are for no one individual to decide.

I was disappointed with the presentation by the Hon. Member for Vaudreuil (Mr. Herbert). He proposed that we have a permanent system of closure in this House, that once a Bill is presented, it automatically be subject to the guillotine, that it automatically be cut off. It is my submission that three and a half days is not sufficient time to debate this issue, namely, the hidden policy in this Bill which is the end of universality. Unless we are prepared to accept and condone the tyranny of the majority, as the Hon. Member for Bow River (Mr. Taylor) so succinctly put it, we must vote against closure on this occasion when it is so completely unwarranted.

**The Acting Speaker (Mr. Blaker):** Order, please. It being 5:03 o'clock, the two hours provided for the consideration of the motion now before the House, under the provisions of Standing Order 82, have expired. Accordingly, under the terms of the Standing Order, it is my duty to interrupt the proceedings and put every question necessary to dispose of the motion.
