A Message was received from the Senate, agreeing to the following Bills, with amendments, viz:—

Bill No. 84 to amend "The General Inspection Act, 1874," and the Act amending it. (On motion of Mr. Baby, the said amendments were taken into consideration, and concurred in.)

Bill No. 107 to amend the Law respecting the removal of obstructions in navigable waters, by wrecks. (On motion of Mr. Pope (P.E.I.), the said amendment was read the first time.—Second reading to-morrow.)

Bill No. 11 relating to Interest on moneys secured by Mortgage of Real Estate. And the said amendments were read, and are as follows:—

Page 1, line 15 .- After "calculated" insert "yearly or;"

Page 1, line 15.—After "calculated insert yearly of Page 2, line 9.—After "mortgage" in ert "provided that this Section shall apply "only to mortgages mentioned in the first Section of this Act, and to all loans by "incorporated companies whether so incorporated under the laws of the Dominion "or elsewhere, secured by mortgage in any manner whatsoever,"—and Clause A.

## Clause A.

"No principal or interest shall be recoverable by sale of lands made under power of sale contained in any mortgage, unless two months' notice shall have been given of the intention to exercise such power of sale in some newspaper published in the "County in which the mortgaged lands are situate!, or if no newspaper be published in such County, then the nearest newspaper in any other County, by one insertion each week; and if any person be living on the lands, or in actual possession, or "cultivation of the same, or any part thereof, unless a copy of such notice be also delivered to such person two months before the day of such sale;"

Page 2, line 10.—Leave out from "by" to "executed" in line 11, and insert

"such mortgages as are referred to in the proviso to the preceding Section."

On motion of Mr. Orton, the said amendments were read the first time.—Second reading, to-morrow.

The Bill No. 123 respecting the Inspection of Petroleum, was read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported, read a third time, and passed.
