Should you decide in favor of cooperating with this Company we are quite willing to bear all expense of development and if and when it is placed upon the market, to contribute to your institution for defraying expense of research an amount equal to 5% of net sales. All of this, of course, should be contingent upon whether or not there are any patents found to interfere with the whole project. Our organization is in a position to proceed at once with the development of this interesting substance, and some of us would be very glad to come to Montreal to discuss the matter with you and to make a final agreement, provided you desire to do so.
