I think we should invite Dr. Adami and Dr. Blair Bell to come here for a week or so and consult with out medical men. I fear that Dr. Bell could not come. I understand privately that Dr. Adami could and would. We should invite Dr. Adami to bring with him two of the young men who are now working under Dr. Bell with the support of Dr. Adami's committee. They could initiate the work here, remaining two or three years. The expectation would be that they would stay for good, and that their work would grow to great proportions. To compensate their services in whole or in part, the fees paid by the patients would be available to any extent.
