Hydro-Electric Power System

In 1912 the City adopted a project to generate power at the Barriere River, some

40 miles north of Kamloops. This great enterprise has cost close upon \$500,000. In 1913 a new power house was built, which with the plant and machinery cost about \$200,000. At present 2500 horse-power can be generated at the Barriere River plant, but 6,000 or 7,000 extra horsepower can be added when required. An additional 2,500 h.p. is also available from the steam plant, used as an auxiliary when needed. The City is now prepared to furnish cheap power and light for manufacturing, domestic or other purposes. It is already supply-

ing the Iron Mask Mine with all its power requirements. Farmers all along the main power line and extensions can utilise it
