

THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL 18.

An Act respecting The Tilsonburg, Lake Erie and Pacific Railway Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The Tilsonburg, Lake Erie and Pacific Railway Company may commence to construct the unconstructed portion of the railway authorized by section 2 of chapter 105 of the statutes of 1902 within two years after the passing of this Act, and may complete the said railway and put it in operation within five years after the passing of this Act; and if, within the said periods respectively, the said unconstructed portion of the said railway is not so commenced, or is not so completed and put in operation, the powers of construction conferred upon the said company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the said railway as then remains uncompleted.

Extension of time.

2. Section 1 of chapter 141 of the statutes of 1909 is repealed.
