THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL 18.

An Act respecting The Tilsonburg, Lake Erie and Pacific Railway Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that 1902, c. 105; White the problem of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The Tilsonburg, Lake Erie and Pacific Railway Extension of Company may commence to construct the unconstructed time. portion of the railway authorized by section 2 of chapter 105 of the statutes of 1902 within two years after the passing 10 of this Act, and may complete the said railway and put it in operation within five years after the passing of this Act; and if, within the said periods respectively, the said unconstructed portion of the said railway is not so commenced, or is not so completed and put in operation, the 15 powers of construction conferred upon the said company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the said railway as then remains uncompleted.

2. Section 1 of chapter 141 of the statutes of 1909 1909, c. 141 amended. is repealed.
