

131. Being in Line, to form Column of Half Preceptories and March to the Front.

*..... Halt Pre-
ceptory Forward ;*

*..... Halt Pre-
ceptory Threes*

*Halt Right (or
Left). — On the*

*command HALF
RIGHT (or LEFT)*

*the right (or left)
half preceptory*

*marches to the
front and the left*

*(or right) half pre-
ceptory executes*

*threes half right (or
left) and marches*

*in this direction
until in rear of it's*

*leading half pre-
ceptory, when the*

*junior subaltern
will give command.....half preceptory threes half*

left (or right).

Forward.—When column is formed, "Forward."

*.....Half Preceptory Forward ;Half Pre-
ceptory Right (or Left)—Turn.—Or, on the word TURN,*

*the leading half preceptory marches to the front, the
remainder turning to the right (or left), and march on*

*until the right (or left) file is in rear of the centre of the
leading half preceptory, when the junior subaltern will*

*give the command right (or left) incline, and when in
column left (or right) incline.*

Forward.—When column is formed, "Forward."
