been disproved by trial, I cannot but have an hope of its fuccefs. For this plan, at the fame time that it offers them our friendship, proves our fincerity, and it has this peculiar advantage, that it will be always before their eyes, in all dispositions, under all circumstances: other offers may be made on either fide at untoward times. in moments of irritation or partial advantage, and may thift and vary with the mo-This will be out of the hands of ment. Ministers, and out of the reach of caprice; and however rooted the Congress may be in their plan of Independence and French connexion. I cannot but think there is in many of the people a diflike to that connexion, and in many more a cordial affection towards their Parent State, not yet obliterated by our usage.

There are befides, if I am rightly informed, divisions of another kind among them, more particular and personal; divisions of faction, enmity, and ambition; no body knows how far these, or the influence of weighty and able men, in the army or the provinces
