

8. After June, 1880, he must have attended the practice of a General Hospital for Twenty-four Months.

9. He must have attended Six cases of Midwifery.

10. He must, before being registered as a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, have passed all the Examinations hereinafter prescribed; and he must have attained the full age of twenty-one years.

11. (a) All persons from registered Colleges outside the Province of Ontario and Quebec, who desire to qualify themselves for registration in this Province, must pass the Matriculation Examination established by the Council, and attend thereafter one full "Winter Course" of Lectures in some one of the Ontario Medical Schools, and such other Course or Courses as may be necessary to complete the Curriculum required by the Council, and shall pass before the Board of Examiners appointed by the Council all the Examinations hereinafter prescribed. This does not apply to Homœopathic Students.

12. (b) Nothing shall exempt residents of Ontario who, after July, 1877, elect to pursue their studies outside of the Province of Ontario, from passing Four Years in the pursuit of their Professional Studies; such Four Years to commence at the date of their passing the Matriculation Examination before the Examiners appointed for the purpose by the Council.

### EXAMINATIONS.

1. Hereafter the Professional Examination shall be divided into two parts—a "Primary" and a "Final."

2. The Primary Examinations shall be undergone at the end of the second Winter Session, and the Final after the fourth Winter Session.

3. The following branches shall be embraced in the Primary Examination:—

- a. Descriptive Anatomy.
- b. Physiology and Microscopic Anatomy.
- c. Chemistry, Theoretical and Practical.
- d. Materia Medica and Therapeutics.
- e. Botany.

4. The following Examination:—

- a. Medical
- b. Theory
- c. Surgery
- d. Surgery
- e. Midwifery
- f. Midwifery
- g. Medical
- h. Sanitary

5. The Primary Examination shall

6. Any Candidate for the Examination shall who at his Final Examination shall have passed, and a subsequent Examination

N.B.—Those who fail in the Examination shall be allowed to sit for the Examination again at the next Session.

7. The new Regulations shall be in force from and after the 1st of April, 1881.
