

## HUN PERSECUTION OF LILLE INTENSIFIED

Mayor Says He Has Not Courage to Expose People Further and "Pays With Knife at Throat"

Paris, Oct. 20.—The treatment of Lille at the hands of the German government, von Gravels, is typical of the Hun's utter disregard of the spirit and letter of the Hague Convention. The following protest dated July 17 from Mayor M. de Lasalle speaks for itself: "Excellency—The contents of your letter of the 1st July filled me with stupefaction. Scarcely have we paid the balance of the forced levy of 24,000,000 francs than you demanded a fresh sum of 33,000,000. During the first year of occupation, when the city of Lille still possessed a large portion of its resources, you demanded 28,000,000 francs. The second year you demanded 33,000,000 francs. The third year, when the town was in most utter distress, trade annihilated, shops closed and industries destroyed, you ask double tribute and raise it to sixty million francs. Such demands, continually increasing, are exhorbitant as they are unjustifiable. They are contrary to the spirit of the Hague Convention and are a contradiction of the commentary of the said convention made by the German general staff itself. These contributions are fixed without justification and rest on no arbitrary foundation. Instead of diminishing they increase the proportion as requisitions, ruin and devastation accumulate on the unhappy town.

## Lauder, In Heart Of N. Y. Money District, Helps Liberty Loan

New York, Oct. 20.—Harry Lauder disorganized the machinery of Wall street for half an hour yesterday, when in an impassioned appeal for subscriptions to the Liberty loan, he addressed a crowd too great for the podium. Women fainted in the crush and reserves were called out to disentangle the mass of humanity that sought to get within range of the little Scotchman's voice.

Standing on the steps of the sub-treasury, Lauder told of his pride in his son, Captain Jack Lauder, who "went over the top" and never came back. The great crowd was moved to tears, and when he concluded and called for subscriptions, more than \$6,000 was deposited in his hands by clerks and stenographers from neighboring office buildings in less than five minutes.

## BRITISH LOSSES DECREASE

Daily Average of Casualties Among Officers 106, Against 262 Last Year.

London, Oct. 20.—Denying reports from German sources that the casualties among British officers in the recent attacks were "unusually severe," the secretary of the War Office issued a statement showing that the total officer casualties for August in all theatres of the war were 4,358, or a daily average of 139. For September the total officer casualties were 3,182, or a daily average of 106.

The statement points out that the highest daily average of officer casualties in all theatres was in July, 1916, when it reached 262.

"These figures," the statement adds, "include all casualties, however slight. Many officers returned to duty even before the casualties had been published."

## MILLION HOMELESS BY FLOODS IN CHINA

Great Loss of Life and Thousands of Miles of Territory Devastated

Peking, Oct. 10.—The Associated Press correspondent has just completed a two weeks' tour and overland tour of the flooded sections in Shantung, Honan and Chihli provinces. The breaks in the banks of the Yellow River were comparatively unimportant and contribute only slightly to the torrent in the Grand Canal which keeps Tien Tsin under water. There is no danger of the Yellow River resuming its old channel. The correspondent went by boat over thousands of ruined villages and visited many isolated refuge camps.

There are at least 1,000,000 persons homeless and penniless and probably 25,000 square miles of territory has been devastated, with the crops gone and the land still submerged. There has been great loss of life especially among the old, small footed women who were unable to reach the highlands. The torrential rains for six weeks were not equalled in volume in the last fifty years. The rains caused food to be even submerged districts away from the streams.

## SEIZURE AT SHEDIA

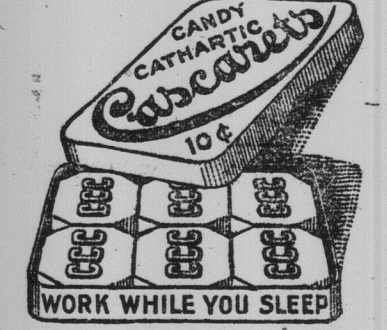
Moncton, Oct. 19.—Moncton police again visited Shedia this morning, armed with search warrants, and returned with more than \$2,000 worth of liquor. They searched eight places for liquor and found it in three. Fourteen cases, one containing ten gallons of gin, two bags and one barrel of liquor, were brought over by automobile, and eighteen barrels and one keg left at Shedia. This is expected to arrive tonight.

One of the places visited was the Weldon House. Harry Brown, of the Weldon House, has been appointed vendor of liquor and will contest the case on these grounds. The cases will probably be heard in Moncton police court Saturday.

## Prohibition In Quebec Province

More Than 1,100 Municipalities in That Province Now in the Dry List

(From the Toronto Star)

The fact that Quebec has voted for prohibition goes far to weaken the popular impression that the province is a stronghold of opposition to prohibition. It must be borne in mind, however, that this impression is gained largely by visiting the two largest cities, Quebec and Montreal. Many smaller municipalities, urban and rural, have no licenses, more than 1,100 having established prohibition.

The action of the Roman Catholic church is worthy of note. It boldly challenged the powerful liquor interests and the inclination of a good many of its members, and threw all its influence on the side of prohibition. Those who imagine that the church is not interested deeply in social reform have here food for reflection. Protestant and Catholic clergy in Quebec joined hands in the work and share in the credit of the victory. It does not appear that the Catholic clergy acted differently from the Protestant ministers. The weapons were prayers and persuasion, not coercion. The Catholic voters did not tremble at the voice of clerical authority. A decisive majority voted as the church desired, but a very substantial majority opposed the church, while in one ward, St. Saviour noted for its fervent piety, hundreds refrained from voting.
