## MISSING IN ST. JULIEN FIGHT APPEARING FOR FIRST TIME IN LIST

Ottawa, June 17.—The heavy list of "missing" Canadian soldiers being issued by the militia department today, aggregating about 400, comprises the accumulation of four or five weeks and includes those who took part in the St. Julien fight in April, and in the subsequent battles. After allowing a reasonable period of time to elapse to permit of men who had been scattered to return to their regiments this list was published by the war office.

Some of the missing men are probably dead but the majority are believed to be prisoners, and now in German prison camps. It is probable that more complete lists of the prisoners will be received from Germany from time to time, under the system of exchange of identification tags.

Further light is thrown on the losses of Col. Currie's 10th Battalion at St. Julien in today's casualty list, announcing that forty-six of its members have been missing since dates between April 24 and 29.
