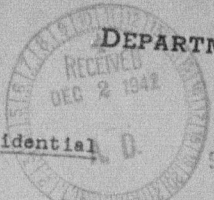

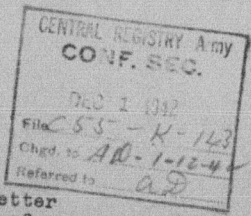

With reference your letter dated 19th November, 1942, under cover of which was enclosed proceedings on the trial by General Court-Martial of the marginally named Officer.

2. The proceedings are being returned herewith and it will be noted that the sentence has been duly promulgated and a minute thereof endorsed on the proceedings underneath the signature of the Confirming Officer.

3. With reference your para. 3, the Officer was suspended from duty on 21st Aug. 1942, and has continued suspended from duty until the date of his dismissal.

4. He was dismissed from the Canadian Army on 26th November, 1942, and the date of promulgation of such dismissal is in accordance therewith.

5. Attached hereto, in triplicate, is a report signed by the Officer Commanding, No. 3A District Depct, in accordance with Article 87 and the Commanding Officer has stated that the only monies given to the Officer on discharge was clothing allowance as authorized by Article 186 F.A. & I.
