Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo (your file No. 21735) regarding confirmation of the Fairford Indian Reserve No. 50 in the Province of Manitoba.

It is noted that you have patented lots Nos. 19 and 20, as well as Nos. 14, 18, 31 and 32, as shown on your plan of the settlement at Fairford Mission, dated 1904.

With regard to Lot No. 15, it is thought you should include this in the part confirmed as an Indian Reserve, as we have no proof that the occupant, Mr. Sterr, is not a Treaty Indian. You are therefore requested to confirm the reserve as shown on the accompanying blue print, excepting therefrom the following lots,- Nos. 14, 18, 19, 20, 31 and 32.

The portion now to be confirmed contains 11338.8 acres, more or less.
