REGULATIONS FOR THE SHOWS

The Committee will be in attendance from 8 to 10 o'clock, on the days of exhibition, to receive the articles, none of which will be admitted after the last named hour, and all are requested to be sent as early as possible.

Competitors are notified that every article must be delivered in a clean and proper state for exhibition; those requiring it, must be made up in neat and suitable packages, and all articles must have their names attached.

· It is absolutely necessary that no article on exhibition be touched or handled, as the Committee wish to deliver the specimens to their respective owners in the best possible condition.

The Committee cannot be accountable for the redelivery of any article, if not claimed within the hour specified by the Committee, from 8 to 10, the morning after the show.

The Judges to have the liberty of cutting any artiele that has to be decided by the taste, and to have the option of refusing Premiums for any article they do not consider worthy.

It is not competent for the Judges to rectify errors in entering articles for exhibition.

Parties entering articles under the wrong class must suffer the loss of their prizes.

Discretionary prizes are fixed; first, at 5s., second at 2s. 6d. .
