(Original with File 1785) I have the honor to inform you that two parties of the Sioux from the Sashatchewan Reserve visited me, being desirous to receive the cows I had promised them and to oblain some ammunition. I gave them a letter to to Mr. Kenziely M. P. P. and supplied them with a small quantity of forwaler and shot. I have since had a letter from hr. ho Kenzie stating that he was about leaving for the Reselve, and would deliver the cows himself and report to me on his return what progress he found the Sioux to be "I believe that they have raised a good supply of potatoes and roots, and some I have the honor to be Your obedient Lervant.
