Another Iceberg Disaster. The Manchester, England, Guardian of recent date says of the missing ship Queen Victoria:

The number of missing vessels posted at Lloyd's this year is now 32—20 British and 12 foreign.—today's official decision of the committee leaving a room for doubt as to the fate of the Glasgow sailing ship Queen Victoria, which left a Chilean port on November 10 last with a cargo of nitrate for the United Kingdom and has not been heard of since.

The Queen Victoria was a fine ship of 157 tons register, and has been commanded by Capt. Charles L. Baker, of Yarmouth, N. S., for about twelve years. Capt. Baker is a brother of E. G. Baker, manager of the Grand Hotel, and was most efficient and popular shipmaster. He was 51 years of age and was unmarried.
