
**Conscription** Measure **Becomes Actual Law**

Toronto, Aug. 28.—Canada's military service bill is now law. It was signed by the Duke of Devonshire, govern-or-general, at Government House here shortly before six o'clock tonight. There had been many rumors as to what course would be taken, but in the end the urgency of the case ently led to the despatch of a messenger to Toronto with the bill for the signature.
