London, Dec. 9. Console 914 a 911. Breadstuffs quiet. Danes' printing house in Lille, France, has been burned. Loss \$300,000.

The Sultan has given \$100,000 for the relief of the famine-stricken inhabitants of Angora. Their prospects are improving.

An anonymous letter, understood to emanate from the Premier of Italy, is published, refuting Depassio's charges against the Italian government published in Paris and Florence. It denies that the Pope is a prisoner, and declares that the Government of Victor Emmanuel will faithfully maintain Papal guarantees.

A gale prevails on the British coast today. A large vessel, supposed to be the John Cook from Quebec for Shields, was totally wrecked and fifteen of the crew were drowned. Nine vessels are ashore at Hartlepool, and several are wrecked at Seaham. Much damage done to houses and other property on shore.

A CHIEF VICTORY. The Bulgarians under Gen. Loma, while endeavoring to free the Carpathian mountains, today a severe fight was defeated.

NEW YORK, Dec. 10. The loss by the burning of the rolling mill of the New York & Jersey Railroad is \$600,000, insured for \$410,000.

TWO MEN WERE KILLED and four dangerously wounded yesterday by the explosion of a boiler near Vicksburg, Miss.
