All Applicants for Examination shall pay such Fees, not Fees to be exceeding the Sums specified in the Table marked (B.) in the paid by Ap-Schedule hereto, as the Board of Trade directs; and such Fees plicants for Examinashall be paid to such Persons as the said Board appoints for tion. that Purpose, and shall be carried to the Account of the Mercantile Marine Fund.

8. The Board of Trade shall deliver to every Applicant who Certificates is duly reported to have passed the Examination satisfactorily, of Comand and to have given satisfactory Evidence of his Sobriety, Exbe granted perience, and Ability, a Certificate of Competency, as First to those who class Engineer or as Second class Engineer, as the Case pass. may be.

9. Certificates of Service for Engineers, differing in Form Engineers from Certificates of Competency, shall be granted as follows; Certificates of Service to that is to say,
